



The Arrival
DELHI - MANALI

Enjoy a scenic drive to Manali in the night. A leisurely drive from NCR, with comfortable stopover, takes about 9 hours by road. On your arrival in the morning, you shall be welcomed with breakfast after checking in at the hotel. We'll have enough time to absorb the mountains and acclimatise and chill the rest of the evening with some famous Cafe exploration and leisure time.

Day 2

Snowy Hills Fiesta MANALI - ROHTANG LA - LEH

We will start out as early as 5 am from Manali crossing Rohtang Pass and entering Lahaul in Himachal. It's criminal to not have steamy hot Maggie in icy cold Rohtang La. Out Journey today will end mid way in Sarchu. We'll check in into the hotel have the evening to ourselves. Brace yourself with bonfire, networking session and crispy snacks.



White Hills Fiesta MANALI - ROHTANG LA - LEH

Straight out from Sarchu, we will be taking another long journey covering Tanglang La, Pang. Gata Loops to reach the biggest town in Ladakh, known as Leh. Leh hosts the Sangam of the Indus and Zanskar Rivers and one of the largest monasteries in all of Asia. Today we will be resting as our Ladakh journey starts tomorrow.

Day 4

Acclimatise EXPLORING LEH

Our journey as a Nomad starts today. First out after breakfast we will be heading to do some wild water rafting in Zanskar. The activity is optional and can be opted for directly on the spot. We will be covering Indus-Zanskar Sangam, Shanti Stupa, Magnetic Hill and Offbeat Monasteries of Ladakh like Thikse and Hemis today. After Leh's local exploration, we will be exploring Leh's marketplace for some café crawls followed by Dinner at the hotel.



The Mountain Desert LEH - NUBRA

Day 6

On the way back to Leh from Pangong, we will also cover a couple more monasteries and practically end our Ladakh tour. Rest of the day post lunch will be on leisure and we will be exploring the night life of leh with some introspection and 'me' time. Dinner will be at the hotel followed by games and socializing.

Day 8

Admiring The Hills LEH - JISPA

Today we will head back to Lahaul and checking in at Jispa after a day's journey passing through the high altitude passes of Tanglang La and Baralacha La. Jispa is a beautiful town in Lahaul and serves as a decent crash pad for our day's end with a view from every corner. Dinner will be at our Swiss Camps.

Day 9

Good Bye JISPA - MANALI - DELHI

Within 6 hours, we will reach Manali and can use the day to explore Old Manali or just at the riverside to disburse the day. Catch your Volvo at night or stay or explore more, it's upto you.

- All payments to be made in advance. We will not allow anyone to board the vehicle until the payments are clear. Cash transfer will not be entertained. No boarding without full payment.
- No boarding without valid govt. approve ID. Your ID will be checked before boarding. No
 pickup/drop will be made en-route. No detours will be made for picking up/dropping people.
 AC will be switched off on the hill and during the waiting time. Also, during the trip, it will be the
 driver's discretion for putting off AC if the road and travel do not support. This is for traveller's
 safety as the route can be dangerous and the vehicle may not be able to pull offload with AC
 running.
- Departure time is given and is fixed. You have to report by that time. It's on you to update status to trip coordinator. Anyone missing the bus will not be entertained for refund etc. and it will not be Kanjoos Traveller's responsibility. We will try to call you twice before departure. Any phone not getting connected will not be KT's responsibility.
- Timings are sacrosanct. Two times follow up will be done on phone. If we are unable to reach/we do not get any communication we will be departing. No refund will be made for late arrival no matter what the reason for the delay is.
- We request not to travel with heavy luggage. Only light luggage or bags are allowed.
 Management shall not take responsibility for a missing item during the trip. Hence, we request not to travel with too many ornaments, jewellery, cash etc.
- All our packages are 'group packages' and the same services/items are applicable for each person in the group.
- Any meal, activity or service not availed by the client will not be adjusted in the package cost and non-refundable under any circumstances.
